

ORDINANCE 2-2020

**CARMICHAELS BOROUGH
GREENE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**AN ORDINANCE OF CARMICHAELS BOROUGH, GREENE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
REGULATING AND PROHIBITING THE ACCUMULATION OR DUMPING OF GARBAGE
AND REFUSE AND REGULATING THE RESTRICTION OF OUTDOOR FIRES WITHIN SAID
BOROUGH AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF**

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and welfare of all the citizens of Carmichaels Borough to establish an Ordinance regulating and prohibiting the dumping of garbage and the restriction of outdoor fires within the Borough.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Carmichaels Borough under and by virtue of, and pursuant to the authority granted by the Borough Code, as amended, does hereby **ENACT** and **ORDAIN** as follows:

SECTION 1: No person, association or firm shall keep or suffer to remain upon his or her premises or on any private property, any garbage, offal, carcass, putrid matter or any other offensive or unwholesome matter or to cast the same upon any piece of ground within said Borough or upon the shores or margin of any stream or body of water or upon any public highway within the limits of said Borough

Nor may any such person use or permit to be used any spot or place within said Borough as a public or private dump for garbage, refuse or rubbish.

SECTION 2: No person or persons shall set or maintain any fire upon any of the highways, streets or alleys or the public grounds in the Borough of Carmichaels or cause to be burned thereon any paper, boxes, rubbish, leaves or other material or substance of any kind.

Nor shall any person or persons set or maintain any fire or burn or cause to be burned any substance or material of any kind out-of-doors within the fire limits of said Borough: Beginning at the corner of South and Pine Street; thence in a Northerly direction on Pine Street to Greene Street; thence in a Westerly direction along Greene Street to Vine Street; then in a Southerly direction along Vine Street to the intersection of Vine and South Streets; thence in an Easterly direction on South Street to Pine Street, the place of beginning.

SECTION 3: Out-of-door fires shall be permitted upon private property in the Borough provided the following regulations and restrictions are strictly adhered to.

1. Every such out-of-door fire shall be built in and confined to a non-combustible container covered with a screen of one-half inch or smaller mesh.
2. No material shall be burned that would give off an offensive, toxic or pungent smoke, gas, fumes or odor.
3. No such fire shall be closer than fifteen feet from any building or property line and shall not be allowed to burn upon any day except between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. provided that it shall be lawful, except on Sunday.
4. Outdoor fires for the purpose of clearing land will require a written notice to the Chief or Assistant Chief of the Carmichaels-Cumberland Township Volunteer Fire Company twenty-four (24) hours prior to such burning.


SECTION 4: Any person who shall violate or fail to conform to any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction pay such fines and costs up to and including imprisonment of not more than thirty (30) days.

SECTION 5: Ordinance 81 of the Borough of Carmichaels, and all other Ordinances or parts of other Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


