

ORDINANCE NO. 1-2020

**CARMICHAELS BOROUGH,
GREENE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

AN ORDINANCE OF CARMICHAELS BOROUGH PROVIDING THAT A PORTION OF SPRUCE ALLEY BE DESIGNATED ONE WAY FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH EAST GEORGE STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH EAST SOUTH STREET AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and welfare of all the citizens of Carmichaels Borough to regulate the flow of traffic and the movement of traffic through the intersections on certain public streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to designate a portion of Spruce Alley as one way from its intersection with East George Street to its intersection with East South Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of Carmichaels Borough under and by virtue of, and pursuant to the authority granted by the Borough Code, as amended, does hereby **ENACT** and **ORDAIN** as follows:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the “Carmichaels Borough Traffic Ordinance 1-2020.”

SECTION 2. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Ordinance is to designate a portion of Spruce Alley as one way from its intersection with East George Street to its intersection with East South Street.

SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS. The Borough shall incorporate into this Ordinance all the definitions that are provided in the Vehicle Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (see 75 Pa. C.S. ' 1, et. Seq.).

SECTION 4. ONE WAY SIGNS. One-way signs are to be erected at the following intersections and no person shall drive or operate his vehicle in contravention of these signs:

<u>STREET WITH ONE-WAY SIGN</u>	<u>INTERSECTING STREET</u>	<u>DIRECTION OF TRAVEL</u>
Intersection of East George Street And Spruce Alley	Intersection of East South Street and Spruce Alley	South
Intersection of Spruce Alley and Gooseberry Alley	Intersection of Spruce Alley with a Business currently Known as Gablers Pharmacy (Drive thru)	South

SECTION 5. REMOVAL OF ANY TRAFFIC SIGNS.

It shall be unlawful for any person to remove any of the one-way signs and any other traffic signs within the Carmichaels Borough without the permission of the Council.

SECTION 6. PENALTIES.

- A. Any person who shall violate Section 4 of this Ordinance relating to stop signs shall, upon conviction before a District Judge or the Court of Common Pleas in Summary proceedings, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars and the cost of prosecution thereof.
- B. Any person who shall violate Section 5 of this Ordinance relating to removal of stop signs and any traffic signs shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine not exceeding Three Hundred and 00/100 (\$300.00) Dollars and/or a period of incarceration in the Greene County Correctional Facility not exceeding ninety (90) days.

SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, or otherwise void for any reason, such decision shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions hereof,

it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise void provision had not been included herein.


SECTION 9. REPEALER. Any Ordinance containing any provision inconsistent herewith to the extent that such provisions are inconsistent, those provisions are also hereby repealed.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.




